

PINS FOR SALE

Listed below are pins previously owned by beloved Chapter Member Bev Bills. Kay McArthur, Insignia Committee Chair, will sell the pins, via email, on a **first-come, first-served basis beginning at 9:00 a.m. on Monday, March 11th, 2024.** Her email is jarbud4516@msn.com.

Funds from this sale will be donated to benefit NSDAR in Bev's name. **Emails requesting to purchase a pin prior to the 9:00 a.m. start time will not be accepted.** However, phone calls and emails regarding general information about a particular pin are welcome. Emails received will be handled in the order they are received.

Caveats and fine print:

These are USED pins and in good condition. Several are engraved as noted. All pins are gold-filled unless specifically listed with "14k". Ancestor bars which state "rider only" means that there is no pin attached, only the rider bar. These pins were sewn onto the ribbon. To **wear** some of the pins on your official ribbon, you must have donated the minimum amount required for Contribution pins; or have served in the particular capacity for Service or Volunteer Committee pins. To make the required donation, contact the DAR Office of Development at 800-449-1776. Purchasing a pin for sentimental reasons, to display in your own home, or if you anticipate meeting requirements soon, etc., is allowed without meeting those requirements, but not worn on an official ribbon. Prices set for the pins are based on what National sells used pins for (roughly 50% of retail value). Pins not sold to chapter members during this sale, will be offered for sale at our State Conference. Any remaining pins will be donated to National.

Once there, you may view many of these pins, see what the requirements are for wearing them on the official ribbon. You can also find a link to the Insignia Store Catalog which has the placement guide in the back.
